


Construction/Traffic Updates : Downtown Vancouver



Apr 2006 - Jul 2009, Station Construction: Vancouver City Centre (Robson) Station On Granville Street between Robson Street and W.Georgia Street -- Micropiling, rock blasting, site preparation and station pit excavation is underway in preparation for the construction of the Canada Line's Vancouver City Centre (Robson) Station.

Traffic Pattern Changes:

- Although westbound vehicle lanes on Robson Street at Granville Street will be periodically obstructed, general east and westbound vehicle lanes on Robson Street will be maintained.

- Pedestrian access to businesses will be maintained.

Oct 2006 - Oct 2009, TBM Exit Shaft Area

On Granville Street between Pender Street and W. Hastings Street -- Update 06.21.07: Canada Line crews will be completing concrete sidewalk work along the east sidewalk on Granville Street between W. Hastings Street and Pender Street beginning at 4:00 a.m. Monday, June 25, 2007. This work will continue until 10:00 p.m., and the sidewalk is scheduled to re-open to pedestrians the morning of June 26, 2007. Pedestrians must use alternative sidewalks in this area while the east sidewalk is being restored.

Granville Street is closed to vehicle traffic between Pender Street and Hastings Street, in preparation for the Tunnel Boring Machine (TBM) exit shaft area.

Traffic Pattern Changes:

- Motorists are not permitted on Granville Street between Pender Street and Hastings Street.

- Pedestrian access around the site and to the businesses will be maintained during construction, although temporary inconvenience may occur when crews are working in the immediate area.

- Any temporary on street parking on Granville Street will be removed prior to the start of construction.

- The east/west commercial laneways in this area will be closed at Granville Street, but businesses may continue to utilize these laneways for loading and unloading. Businesses may also use alternative designated loading and unloading areas on Granville Street and on Pender Street during construction.

-Granville buses are diverted off Granville Street to Seymour Street and Howe Street. In addition, future changes to transit service will be required in this area to accommodate excavation work for the TBM exit shaft and for Waterfront Station on Granville Street. Mar 2006 - Dec 2008, Davie Street Partial Road Closure for Yaletown Station Construction

On Davie Street between Hamilton Street and Pacific Boulevard -- Anticipated to continue until the fall of 2008, Davie Street is closed to vehicle traffic between Hamilton Street and Pacific Boulevard to accommodate Yaletown Station construction.

Traffic Pattern Changes:

- Pedestrian access will be maintained on Davie Street throughout construction, and businesses in the area will remain accessible.

- Vehicles will not be permitted on Davie Street between Hamilton Street and Pacific Boulevard.

- Vehicle access to existing parking lots in the area will also be maintained on adjacent roadways, and signage will be posted in the area to indicate access routes.

- East and westbound buses on Davie Street will be re-routed between Richards Street and Pacific Boulevard, and buses and bus stops will be moved to Drake Street. For transit service information, pleases contact TransLink's Customer Information Centre at 604-953-3333.

May 2007 - Nov 2009, On Hastings Street at Granville

One of the staging areas for Waterfront Station is located on the south side of the W. Hastings Street and Granville Street intersection.

Traffic Pattern Changes:

- During this activity, eastbound and westbound vehicle traffic on W. Hastings Street is reduced to a minimum of one lane in each direction.

- Two-way vehicle traffic will be maintained at all

times.

- Pedestrian crosswalks will be maintained on three sides of the intersection with the south crosswalk closed during this activity.

Jan 2007 - Aug 2009, Waterfront Station: Site Preparation Work

On Granville Street between W. Hastings Street and Cordova Street -- Effective January 3, 2007 until the summer of 2009, Granville Street is closed to vehicles between W. Hastings Street and Cordova Street in preparation for Waterfront Station construction activity.

Traffic Pattern Changes:

- Motorists will not be permitted on Granville Street between W. Hastings Street and Cordova Street.

- Pedestrian access around the site and to the businesses will be maintained during construction, although temporary inconvenience may occur when crews are working in the immediate area.

- All work will be conducted in accordance with the City of Vancouver's Noise Control bylaw.

- Future changes to transit service will be required in this area to accommodate excavation work for Waterfront Station
